

Global Food Regulatory Framework on Exports



Discussed the importance of food safety and quality in global trade, emphasizing India's \$4 billion and \$8 billion exports in spices and marine products, respectively. Provided insights into the Codex Alimentarius Commission's role in setting international food standards, highlighting India's achievements and leadership in Codex activities. Stressed the need for industry engagement in Codex to influence standards, proposing collaboration between industry, government, and stakeholders to enhance food safety practices.

Discussed the regulatory challenges faced by the Spices Board, emphasizing issues with ethylene oxide and pesticide residues. Highlighted the importance of harmonizing domestic standards with international requirements and the need to collaborate with pesticide manufacturers to expand label claims for minor crops like spices. Proposed a conclave to address pesticide issues and improve standards.



Emphasized the global significance of Codex Alimentarius as a standard-setting body, highlighting its intergovernmental nature and its role in ensuring food safety, fair trade practices, and harmonized international trade standards. They elaborated on India's active participation in Codex committees, citing examples like contributions to standards for spices and marine products, which have bolstered Indian exports and safeguarded domestic industry interests.

Outlined the growth of the marine products industry and challenges like regulatory issues and quality standards. Highlighted the need for improved cold chain infrastructure and biosecurity measures in aquaculture, calling for government support to assist

Outlined plans to organize a training course on microbiological sampling and testing methods and committed to sharing reference materials with participants. He also addressed the issue of retesting challenges in microbiological analysis.

Guidance document for Quality Management of Health Supplements, Nutraceuticals, Food for Special Dietary Use, Food for Special Medical Purpose, and Prebiotic and Probiotic Food



Nutraceuticals and health supplements must comply with detailed regulations, including guidelines for quality management systems, testing frequencies for raw materials and finished products, and categories such as special dietary use and medical purposes. Quality control is critical, requiring food business operators (FBOs) to ensure compliance through rigorous testing and adherence to standards for manufacturing processes.

MSMEs face challenges in meeting testing requirements, especially regarding pesticide residues and raw material sourcing, highlighting the need for targeted awareness programs and traceability initiatives for farmers. To address these issues, stakeholder engagement and regular regulatory guidance meetings will focus on educating FBOs, implementing verification programs, and clarifying compliance responsibilities for sustainable growth.

Refresher Training for Food Safety Officers (FSOs) by FSSAI



Shared updates on recent developments in FOSCOS, including a planned live demo to showcase key functionalities, such as enforcement follow-ups and hygiene ratings. New bulk improvement notices will be introduced for non-compliant FBOs, along with a risk-based inspection module to prioritize high-risk units, while user ID management and streamlined application processes were discussed for state authorities.

The launch of the adjudication flow and digital forms for legal sampling aims to enhance efficiency, supported by a new data analytics tool for improved data retrieval. Participants raised concerns about system functionalities and suggested improvements, particularly around clarifying officer roles and responsibilities.

Interactive Session: Milk & Oil Fortification






